



Use of Face Coverings

All persons, including employees and volunteers, outside vendors, and patrons, entering the Library must wear a face covering that covers nose and mouth and must maintain a six-foot distance from all other persons when practicable. Reasonable accommodations such as no-contact curbside service and digital and virtual resources are available to those who are medically prevented from or decline to wear a face covering. Those refusing to wear a face covering that covers nose and mouth and/or to maintain six-foot distance when practicable shall be required to leave the Library. Those who refuse to leave shall be banned for a period of ninety (90) days.

This policy shall remain in place until such time that it is deemed no longer necessary by the Illinois Department of Public Health, the Cook County Department of Public Health, and the Morton Grove Public Library Board of Trustees.
